It will do great work, if I work.

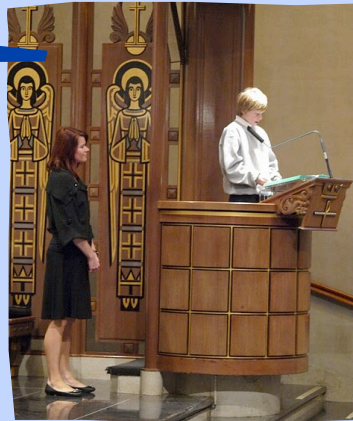
It will be prayerful, if I pray.

It will bring others into its worship, if I invite and bring them.

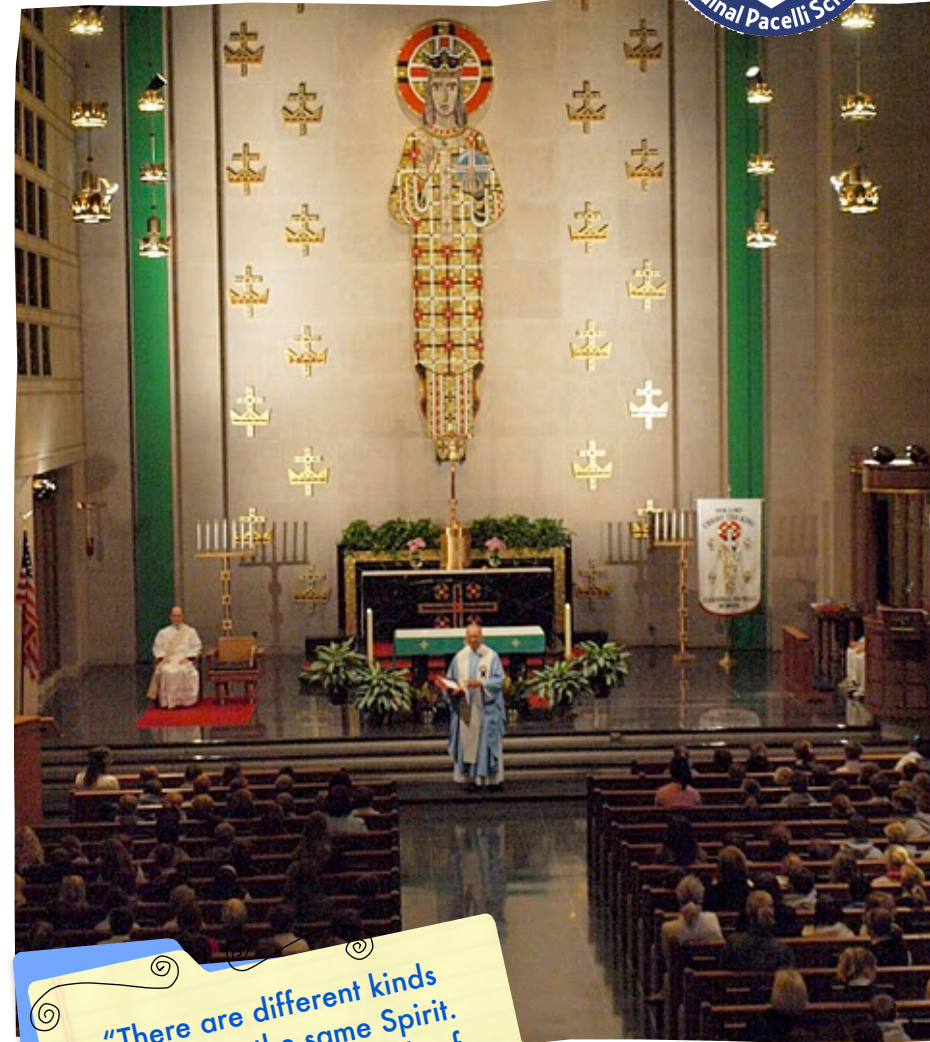

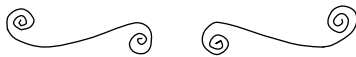

The CCD program offers religious education to students in grades 1-8 who do not attend a Catholic school. Sacrament preparation is given and all students are made more aware of God's presence in their lives.

## **RCIA - Father Obermeyer, 321-4121**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a process of study and formation where individuals learn about the Catholic faith and reflect on their personal faith journey using Scripture, prayer, questions and discussion. The process helps one prepare to join our family of believers.

## **Just Faith - Linda Gloeckler, 321-4121**

JustFaith offers an opportunity for parishioners to experience a spiritual journey into compassion. Focusing on the social teachings of the Catholic Church, JustFaith provides a lively and thought provoking format to read, discuss, pray, experience and be formed by our justice tradition that, when lived out, changes lives, inspires faithful witness, and transforms the world through love and service. The program is held September through the beginning of May.

## **School Education Advisory Committee - John Jorden, 321-4121**

The SEAC formulates policies for the administration of Cardinal Pacelli School and other educational groups of the parish. It is subject to the guidelines of the Archdiocese Education Commission. The committee consists of six discerned members of the parish and ex-officio members--pastor, principal, faculty, and PTO president.

The purpose of the Cardinal Pacelli PTO is to advance the interests of education, support the school community, promote students' welfare, and bring parents and teachers into closer communication. Nearly forty committees provide enrichment to the children's education. PTO's funding of artist-in-residence programs, Everybody Counts, COSI, and What's Right?, adds value to a well-rounded academic curriculum. PTO purchase of classroom supplies and playground equipment, as well as its financial support of the science room and computer lab provides students with state-of-the-art learning tools.
