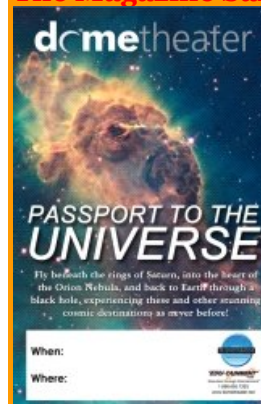
## Springer School Free Parent Seminar Tomorrow Night
