MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

I will be sending home a form for all those with medications in the clinic soon. Please indicate on the form(s) how you would like to pick up the medications and return the form to school.

Grades which have new immunizations required for entrance to school in August are Kindergarten and 7th grades. I will be sending home reminders to 6th grade parents regarding this. Kindergarten parents can pick these up at the Kindergarten kick-off on May 5.

I will be sending home blank forms for students who currently have prescription medications at school. Please have the student's doctor fill these out this summer, so they are ready for school entrance in August. This would include students with asthma and food allergies requiring medication at school.

FINE ARTS

The Art of Ballet:

On April 12, the Cincinnati Ballet brought the power of dance to our school. In an eye-catching program, students Preschool through 8th Grade were provided a peek into the typical day in the life of a professional ballet dancer, learned the fundamentals of the art of ballet, gained an understanding of the discipline and athleticism required for this career, and enthusiastically participated in the dance demonstration and fun coordination exercises.



Paschal Art Masterpiece:

The 1st and 2nd Graders completed another colorful JellyBelly Bean mosaic to adorn our school walls. Fourteen pounds of JellyBelly beans were arranged in a manner that depicts Our Lord Christ the King Church at Easter sunrise; surrounded by Easter lillies (spring flowers that have a trumpet shape symbolizing living forever with God), a butterfly (life cycle symbolizing eternal life), and red eggs (the early Christian symbol of the tomb symbolizing the resurrection).

Art with a (Re)purpose:

HaloMiner provided workshops for the 3rd, 6th, 7th, and 8th Graders. Beautiful collective works of art were created using a variety of repurposed materials. The 6th graders even honed their sewing skills using discarded fabrics and vintage buttons. The masterpieces will be available for viewing/buying in the Studio927 Art Gallery Auction at Junefest. These projects taught the importance and creativity of re-using materials around us and left no environmental impact.
