MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

I am seeing a lot of children with itchy, red eyes, which interferes with their ability to fully concentrate on learning. There is now an over-the-counter antihistamine eye drop, which is approved for ages 3 and over, which lasts up to 12 hours. Thus a parent could give the eye drop prior to school and it should last all day. If your student has this problem, check with his/her doctor if these eye drops would be appropriate for them.
