I hope you have gained all the information needed for a successful school year for your child.

We have some pretty spectacular teachers and staff on team Pacelli that are with your children daily cheering them on, imparting knowledge, and helping them to develop spiritually. The blessings just keep coming!

8th grade parents are invited to an **HSPT Information Night on Tuesday, September 6th @ 7:00 p.m.** to discuss the HSPT test prep being conducted by Powers Educational Services. Marion Powers will be here to describe the program to you and answer any questions. On Saturday, September 10th, an optional HSPT Diagnostic Test will be given to the 8th graders @ 9:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. at Cardinal Pacelli School. Please arrive to school by 9:15 a.m. and enter at the side door by the soccer field. I will be there awaiting their arrival. They will be taking the test in their 8th grade homerooms. A check for \$25 to Powers Educational Services will be collected on the day of the test. Test prep sessions will be held during the school day and should begin the week of September 19th.

I have received the scores for all students who participated in the Ohio State testing. The results will be sent home tomorrow with the oldest member of those families who participated in this testing. Several students in grade 8 took the End of the Course Test for High School Algebra I.

95% of the students taking the test received at or above the required score! Congratulations for a job well done Mrs. Parker and her Math students.

With these funds, we were able to purchase new teacher desktops designed specifically for our needs.
