MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Pacelli Families,

I cannot believe the end of the year is here in two days. This week has been jam-packed with graduations and award ceremonies. We will end the year with an all school mass on Friday, May 26 at 8:15 AM. Our 8th graders will then have their special celebratory Mass for graduation in the evening at 6:00 PM.

Before we end the school year, I thought I would share some new initiatives for next year. Many of these have come out of comments from the parent survey both this year and last year. As you already know, we will be serving lunch through a new vendor, Kaldi's. They are present in several of our Archdiocesan schools and we are all very excited that they are joining our team.

Next year we will be offering French classes for after school enrichment along with Drama Club. Drama will be age specific and in the fall students in grades 5-7 will meet on Thursday afternoons to practice for the play/musical which will be performed on Thursday, December 7th for the school and then in the evening for all family and friends. The students are delighted that this will be an option for them next year. I think they were inspired by the 8th grade musical this year. We will also focus on the little ones in the spring for grades 2-4. Again meeting on Thursdays after school for the practices with a performance for both school and families on April 26th. I can't wait to see all their creativity come alive!

Students in grade 4 will each have a class set of chromebooks for their daily use next year. Teachers will have technology readily available to use across their curriculum enhancing student learning. An introduction to Spanish for grades 4 and 5 with the use of a program called Duolingo will be added to next year's curriculum. This program which will provide a foundation for the language as they anticipate Spanish class in grade 6.

We have added Schoolbelles as a uniform vendor. Next year our girls will have an option to purchase the jumper or skirt of their choice, depending on their age/grade. Just like Lands End, a percentage of the sales will go directly to the PTO to use for many of the programs they organize for our students. The link for Schoolbelles will be added to our website soon.

In early fall, Grades 7 and 8 will attend a day long outing to Camp Joy promoting leadership and team building. They have spectacular programs for our youth focusing on different kinds of leadership and how to use it effectively along with collaborative activities to instill teamwork. The students were very excited to learn about this trip. Details on the date and time have not been finalized. When that information is available, I will share it with you through email later in June.

Last but certainly not least, we are implementing a school-wide theme of RESPECT next year! The teachers and I have already begun making plans on specifics and how it will be carried out throughout the entire year.

Our students are great gifts from God and we should all celebrate our diversity and embrace these gifts with a Christian attitude and thankfulness for the opportunity to share them with others.

We have two additional goodbyes on our Pacelli faculty and staff. **Ms. Laura DeBrunner** will be moving on to pursue new opportunities in the music profession. She says, "It has been a joy to work and collaborate with each one of you. Thank you for creating a teaching community full of encouragement and positivity." Also, **Mrs. Marsha Strominger** will not be returning next year as our school nurse. She intends to go into another direction in the field of nursing. We thank Ms. DeBrunner and Mrs. Strominger luck in their new pursuits.

As we close another year of growth, I want to thank you all so much for the support I have been given by the parents and friends of Pacelli. Without each other, ideas and tasks cannot be fully developed and our goals cannot be met in making Cardinal Pacelli a premier educational community. Always remember that we are committed to providing a nurturing environment focused on the spiritual, academic, and social abilities of each and every child who enters our doors.

TO ALL PARENTS OF CURRENT 4TH THRU 7TH GRADE STUDENTS

Cardinal Pacelli will be releasing the following directory information to the Archdiocesan School Office for distribution to Catholic High Schools within the archdiocese for students who will be in grades 5-8 for the 2017-2018 school year UNLESS the parent/guardian has submitted a Request to Restrict Directory information to the school office prior to **June 7th**.

Information to be released is as follows: Student Name, Address, Home or Primary Phone Number, Grade Level, Gender, Parent-email address.

INCOMING 8TH GRADERS

As we have done for the past few years, Powers Educational Services has been contracted to work with your child for the HSPT test prep beginning in September. The cost for 8 classes, held during the school day, is already part of your fees for the school year.

Several parents have requested that we offer an optional diagnostic test this spring instead of in September. Mrs. Powers will be here at Cardinal Pacelli on Tuesday, May 30 @ 9:00 - 11:30 to administer this test. With this test comes an analysis of your child's strengths and areas to work on. The cost of this optional test is \$50.

If you are interested, please make a check payable to Powers Educational Services. You can bring payment on the day of the test. Mrs. Cento will be here to let all students into the building. Please enter at the side door of the school by the grassy field.

BUS SERVICE FOR THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

Residents of Cincinnati:

If your child currently rides the bus, your service will automatically be renewed for next school year. Your 2017-

18 route number, stop & times will be assigned in late summer. This information will be mailed to you directly from Cincinnati Public prior to the start of the school year in the form of a small yellow postcard. If you are eligible for bus service, but did not utilize service this year and want your child routed for the 2017-18 school year, you will need to submit a Reinstate Service Form. If your child gained service this year by filling out a Space Available Form your service IS NOT automatically renewed. This will be an option in mid September. You will need to fill out a new Space Available form in the fall. Space Availability is not reviewed/considered until AFTER the first reroute which takes place two weeks after the start of school. Both forms can be found on Cincinnati Public's website <https://www.cps-k12.org/> under Transportation, Yellow Bus Service, then scroll down to Forms. Please fax all forms directly to First Student. The fax number is located on the bottom of each form.
