MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

More facts about concussions: Symptoms of a concussion fall into 4 main categories:

- 1) "**Thinking and Remembering**" which includes not thinking clearly, feeling slowed down, concentration problems, and difficulty remembering new information.
- 2) "**Physical symptoms**" which includes nausea/vomiting, headache, blurry vision, dizziness, sensitivity to light or noise, balance problems and having no energy.
- 3) "**Emotional and mood**" Evidence of this is being easily upset or angry, sad, or nervous.
- 4) "**Sleep**" including sleeping more or less than usual, or having difficulty falling asleep.
