Our faculty and staff are working on a book study using Carol Dweck's book **Mindset The New Psychology of Success**. We are using the book and a series of videos to help understand the researched theory of success being rooted in a Fixed or Growth Mindset. "Should you tell your kids they are smart or talented? Professor Carol Dweck answers this question and more. as she talks about her groundbreaking work on developing mindsets. She emphasizes the power of "yet" in helping students succeed in and out of the classroom." Professor Dweck shares good research in Mindsets with very practical ways we can all improve.

Did you know that Cardinal Pacelli School has a Health and Wellness policy? Located on pages 45-47 in the School Handbook, it outlines our commitment in providing a school environment which promotes and protects children's health, well-being and ability to learn by supporting healthy eating and physical activity. The teachers and myself are spending sometime reviewing this policy and enforcing the current guidelines. As needed, we will be making a few adjustments for the betterment of all of our students. I am asking for your help in supporting a healthier environment by minimizing sugary snacks for your child and treats for classroom celebrations. I would also ask that when visiting the classrooms

and volunteering in the cafeteria and playground, that you resist the urge to bring in a treat for the students. In the classrooms, the teachers will be working towards a reward system that more frequently uses non-food items with an increase in specific and wise forms of praise. Praising the process of learning focusing on effort, strategies and perseverance of a task are keys to growing good humans.

Let's not let the information learned from the Anti-Bullying speaker, Jim Bisenius, be a one-shot deal. He gave us the tools. Now we need to utilize the strategies he shared and are outlined in a handout which I provided through email after his presentation. We are all responsible for our happy and healthy school environment where all students feel welcomed and cared for. We need leaders in our classrooms who are courageous to stand up for what is right and model respectful behavior. I am asking that all students not be bystanders but be significant in creating a harmonious school community. Thank you for your support!
