Dear Pacelli Families,

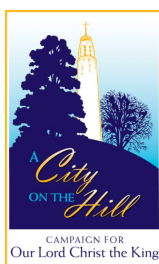

MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

October 10th was World Mental Health Day. One in five people in the US have a mental illness, with 50% of all mental illnesses beginning by age 14. The theme for this year is "psychological and mental health first aid for all". The US House of Reps. passed the Mental Health First Aid Act on Sept. 26th. If it passes the Senate, the bill would authorize \$15 million in funding to train critical populations- like teachers, veterans, police and other first responders in mental health first aid.
