MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Pacelli Parents and Friends,

It is with great sadness that I need to share with you the passing of one of our 7TH grade parents. Michelle Schoettmer lost her long battle with cancer on Tuesday morning. Please keep the Schoettmer family in your prayers as they navigate through this most difficult time. Visitation for Michelle will be held at Rohde Funeral Home on Friday from 4 - 7 p.m. The funeral mass will be this Saturday, Sept. 30th at 10 a.m. at Our Lord Christ the King Church. Students gathered this afternoon in church to say a rosary for Mrs. Schœttmer. It was a very nice way to remember her and to give comfort to Caroline.

After a massive restructuring on the process of selection and the procedures of Student Council, elections were finally held on Tuesday. Students had to adhere to several criteria and then with input from the faculty and an election of their peers the council is created. Students will be informed of the election on Friday afternoon. Sometimes you will receive an e-mail with information regarding their visit. You are more than welcome to make a call to the office if you need clarification. In the case of a more serious illness or incident, you will continue to receive a phone call from our staff. I hope you are enjoying the academic updates that are automatically generated via RenWeb. At this time, there is no way to disarm this portion for individual families. While we wait for a solution to be identified from RenWeb, you can delete the correspondence if you choose to or enjoy this gift which keeps you up to date on the progress of your child(ren).

Please remember that parking is very thin this year for our wonderful volunteers. When coming to school, you may need to park on the street or if you arrive before 11:00 AM you may find an open spot along the fence line in the back. However, parking in this area will greatly shrink the recess area (basketball hoops and 4-hole) for the children.
