**Our school website has also updated the information for you to make it easy to get answers and to apply. We are now in year two of the tuition assistance program. If you were awarded last year, you will need to re-apply. The assistance is only good for one year.**

The deadline for applying for the AOC aid is January 31, 2017. You **MUST** apply for this program to be considered for the **Cardinal Pacelli's Education Fund**. I want to make sure that our families at Cardinal Pacelli School have all the information and details necessary to apply for this program to help with the cost of tuition at our school.

I am happy to report that our fiscal responsibility has paid off and tuition for next school year will only increase slightly. Keeping tuition down and manageable for all families is a top priority for me. Tuition numbers along with a few minor changes in Pre-School and Pre-K times will be available soon.

I will be sending out a separate email with directions on this year's on-line registration for new students and re-enrollment of current students. RenWeb and FACTS are now partnered which will make tuition and fee payments linked to our school management system. FACTS charges a one-time \$25 application fee for families registering any new student to Pacelli.

I hope you are enjoying these last few days of January and are on the edge of your seats for Catholic Schools Week! This is ALWAYS a highlight to our year.
