Dear Pacelli Friends & Families,

I hope yesterday was the last of the snow days. I do work hard to get the information to you in a timely fashion but there are several pieces that I need to do before the information gets sent out. My goal is to get that decision out to you by 6:00 AM in order for you to make arrangements for your day. I apologize if phone calls and emails are not getting to you soon enough.

I hope you all received the email regarding school registration and re-enrollment for the up-coming 2018-19 school year. To complete our online re-enrollment process, you will access our ParentsWeb through your existing login. If you do not have a login, please follow the [Instructions for Creating a ParentsWeb Login](#) listed below.

- Select **Logins** from the menu bar and **ParentsWeb Login** from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.
- After logging in, click on the **Family Information** button in the left menu.
- Click on the **Enrollment/Reenrollment** button.

This year has gone by really fast. We are looking so forward to next school year and are already making plans. Getting our enrollment numbers by March will help us plan for personnel and materials for the new year. I am currently working on the school calendar for next year. Construction on the new building will be completed by the end of June and the renovation to the cafeteria will be completed by the beginning of the new school year. It is my hope that we will not start the new year in the teens but a definite start date has not been determined. This information should be available soon.

We are getting the final totals of scholarship dollars earned by our 8th grade students from the HSPT (High School Placement Test) taken in November 2017. We are happy to report that 98% of our 8th graders have been admitted to the high schools of their first choice and one was admitted to the second choice. As of today, all 8th graders will be attending a Catholic High School in the Archdiocese. To date, 30% of our 8th graders have acquired approximately \$216,800 in scholarships from these schools based on their scores from the High School Placement Test and many of them have been accepted into Advanced classes, Honors classes and Accelerated Honors.

We are so proud of all of their efforts and wish them well.

Panther Baseball Update

While T-Ball and Coach Pitch numbers are typically strong, historically registration numbers for baseball vary class to class and year to year. This variability makes it difficult to predict whether your child's Pacelli cohort will provide enough participants to field an entire team of 11-12 players. To mitigate the risk that Cardinal Pacelli cannot field a team- particularly in grades 3 and above- we will be pairing with St. Mary's Parish to provide as many recreational-level baseball team options as possible. The simple plan is to pool all registrants and form teams from both schools (similar to what is done in football) or multiple grades (similar to the model used in soccer) to provide a consistent, fun and convenient product for your child/family.

Regardless of which school sponsors the team, your child's baseball experience in terms of level of competition, the locations of the scheduled practices and games will remain the same. You will be signing up for a recreational baseball product, played at the neighborhood level.
