If you were awarded last year, you will need to re-apply. The assistance is only good for one year. The deadline for applying for the AOC aid is January 31, 2018. You MUST apply for this program to be considered for the Cardinal Pacelli's Education Fund. I want to make sure that our families at Cardinal Pacelli School have all the information and details necessary to apply for this program to help with the cost of tuition at our school.

Complete the Online Application (OA):

- Click on the Admissions Tab at the top of the page
- You will see **How to Apply** to create an account for a new student
- Once you have created an account, you will receive this email -

"Your parent account has been created, but you must click the Verify Account link below to log in and complete the email verification process."

- After verifying the account, you will be able to proceed with the Online Application (OA)
- In order to **complete the process**, you will be required to pay an application fee from RenWeb/FACTS
- Before you can proceed to enrollment, your application will be reviewed and you will be notified.

If you are only re-enrolling your child(ren), please [CLICK HERE](#) to read the School Admissions Policy and then click Online Enrollment to complete the process for your child(ren) for next school year. There will be a registration fee for each child. \$200 of this fee will be applied to tuition.
