Dear Pacelli Families & Friends,

Cooler weather means clothing changes. Through the remainder of

October, students can continue to wear navy blue uniform shorts or on PE days their Pacelli school PE shorts. Beginning on November 1st, shorts can no longer be worn. Students will either wear their navy blue uniform pants, or if it is a PE day, solid navy or black sweat pants or the Spiritwear athletic pants with the Panther logo. Tights and leggings for all students in grades K – 8 will follow the same colors as the socks – solid white, navy or black.

Spiritwear can only be worn on designated days within the classroom but feel free to wear it to and from school and at recess. With the weather getting cooler, I know there some very nice spiritwear outerwear choices.

Attendance Quoting from the Cardinal Pacelli School Handbook: "Excused absences include reasons of illness or a death in the family. Upon returning to school after an absence, the student must bring a note to the homeroom teacher giving the reason for the absence. Student absences due to illness, doctor appointments, or death in the family are considered an excused absence. Excessive absenteeism [over fifteen (15) days] may result in request for a doctor's note for all absences. "Absences of convenience" are strongly discouraged because they express a devaluation of the importance of education and will be recorded as an unexcused absence. Student absences due to vacation trips are considered an unexcused absence. Students and parents assume full responsibility for the work missed during an unexcused absence. 
