Mrs. Cento's Weekly Message

Dear Pacelli Families & Friends,

Fall is here! This is just a reminder that this is the last week students are permitted to wear shorts as part of their uniform. This includes our PE shorts. Beginning on Tuesday, November 1st, all students will either wear long navy pants, skirts, jumpers, or solid navy blue or black sweat/athletic pants or navy athletic pants bought through spirit wear for PE class. I know your child has probably grown a foot since the spring. Hopefully, you have already anticipated this uniform change coming and are already prepared.



Mass I thought I would clear up a misconception that seems to be going around regarding our All-School Friday Masses. When the school year started, Fr. Adam wanted us to use the readings of the day for the Liturgy of the Word. Since sometimes these readings can be longer and have a little more advanced vocabulary, we decided to begin the year having our older students do the readings. This was not intended to last the entire school year but

until the teachers had a better idea of the reading abilities of all their students. Since we have now been in school for 10 weeks, you will begin seeing this evolve.

Using the schedule of grade level masses already created, your child may be given the Reading of the day, Responsorial Psalm, or a petition to share in Mass. Our older students have done a fantastic iob with this. and I can't wait to hear some of our vouncer students at the podium at

Mass leading us in prayer in the future. Later in the year, we hope to transition to the Responsorial Psalm being sung from the choir loft at the direction of our Music Director.

Regarding our First Holy Communion Mass for our Grade 2 students on Sunday, May 7th at 12:00 PM, this is considered a sacramental Mass and those receiving the Eucharist for the first time should only be focused on the reception of the sacrament and not worry about additional duties in the Mass. Just like when our students in Grades 7 & 8 receive Confirmation, others in the community read so the children can focus on the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation. This is an exciting time for our second graders. They spend the entire year in preparation using a variety of materials and experiencing many activities. Their focus is on this **Gift From God to Them**.

Just Try It The idea of the Just Try It event is to get children to try food they typically wouldn't try. We schedule a few times per year for this event. On Monday, October 24th, the Health & Wellness Committee made a mango salsa with 4 ingredients...mangos, onion, cilantro and lime juice.



WOW! The kids really liked this. We also made a tomato/roasted red pepper soup. We liked the idea of having a colorful food that might draw some kids in to try it! Here are a couple of happy faces for Just Try It!



Morning Tardies Mornings are the worst for me. I am a night owl and I love to sleep in but during the week, when my alarm goes off at 5 AM my day begins. That is early but I definitely need time to get myself going and ready for the day. I am sure many of you face similar situations at home with getting yourselves ready for the day plus your children. I ask for those of you who seem to be tardy on a regular basis to do some trouble shooting at home to find a solution. It may just be a matter of leaving your home 5 minutes

earlier. It will produce the benefit of your child being able to begin his/her school day without stress and will help our record keeping and the flood of students in the school office for tardy slips in the morning. Thanks for your attention and cooperation in this.




