**RenWeb** We are mid-way through our first trimester of the new school year. Trimester 1 will end on Friday, November 4 with Parent/Teacher Conferences scheduled for Monday, November 7. Students in grades 5-8 and their parents have access to all graded assignments using RenWeb. You can gain access to the Family Portal through our school website. Look at the top right of the page and you will click Family Portal. It will take you to the RenWeb Family Portal site. **CP-OH is the district code.** Another way to get access is by using an app on your phone or tablet. **FACTS Family** app will allow you to login and get the same information as you would get from your other devices.



**Picture Day** Come with your brightest smiles on Monday, October 3 for our school pictures. Please consult with the school handbook on appropriate clothing to wear for this out of uniform day. Remember, our younger ones will be playing outside on the playground and some of the students will have PE class this day.

**Pacelli Village Playground** New temporary signage is now displayed for our Pacelli Playground. The teachers and I are continuing to emphasize the importance of following these rules in the hopes that it will carry over to the evenings and weekends. Following these guidelines will protect the safety of everyone and protect our playground from misuse and vandalism. 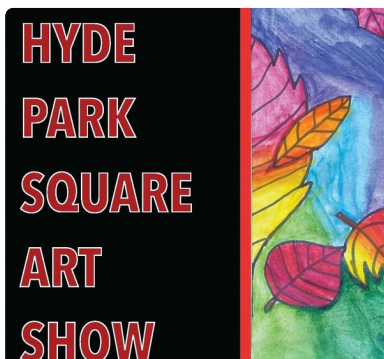

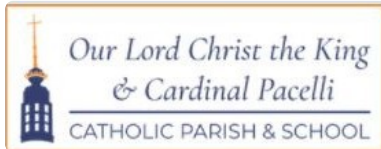
