Student Council – Thankful Feather Food Drive

Student Council is sponsoring a protein food drive for our friends at St. Vincent de Paul. Beginning today through Friday, November 18th, please bring in the following canned protein to support the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry. Kindergarten - Canned beans 1st grade - Canned chicken 2nd grade - Canned beef 3rd grade - Canned pork 4th grade - Canned ham 6th grade - Canned salmon/mackerel 7th grade - Canned sardines/anchovies 8th grade - Canned bacon/chicken

For every two canned goods a student brings in, they will get a feather from their teacher. On this feather, the student will write something they are thankful for. The feathers will be put into the Feather Drop Box. These feathers will be displayed on a turkey outside the Kindergarten classrooms for all to see.

Cans will be collected within the classrooms and on November 18th, Student Council Representatives will collect the cans. Our goal as a school is to fill the turkey with Feathers. Thank you for participating.


