Happy Third Week of Advent!



The third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday and is meant to remind us of the joy that the world experienced at the birth of Jesus, as well as the joy that the faithful have reached the midpoint of Advent. Gaudete is the Latin word meaning "rejoice."

<u>Christmas Break</u> We have four more days until our Christmas Break which begins at 11:01 AM on Tuesday, December 20th. We will return to the classroom on Wednesday, January 4, 2023!

<u>Bus Transportation</u> There will be bus transportation on **Tuesday**, **December 20th**, **2022**. Please plan accordingly. Your child will arrive home in the middle of the day with our **11 AM dismissal time**. They will need someone at home to greet them.

<u>After-School Care</u> On Tuesday, December 20th, Champions will **not** provide after school care for your children. All Staff will dismiss from school after every child has safety departed the school grounds to begin our Christmas Break.

#### <u>Christmas Concert - Thursday, December 15th @ 7:00 PM</u>

It's the most wonderful time of the year for our **Early Learners – Grade 4 Christmas Concert.** It's been a while since this has taken place in-person and on the stage in the gym. We are so glad it is back to put us all in the Christmas/Holiday spirit! All Early Learners – Grade 4 will perform with their grade in this concert. Students should arrive by **6:30 PM and go directly to their classrooms**. Their teachers will greet them and get them lined up for the program to begin. While waiting for their stage appearance, the bleachers will be used.

The dress for the concert is **festive**, **holiday colors and designs**. Be mindful that while on stage, the lights can be quite hot so dress accordingly. The concert will be roughly an hour long and is a glorious payoff for all the hard work our students at the direction of Mr. Drewyor, have done so far this year. #### **Emergency Closing of School**

#### **Catholic Education Foundation Tuition Aid Grants**

The application window for Catholic Education Foundation (CEF) 2023-2024 Elementary School Tuition Assistance Scholarships is open between now and February 3, 2023. The process will work, as it has in the past with families applying through **FACTS Grant and Aid Management**. Families should upload their 2021 tax return when applying, this eliminates the need to wait for 2022 to be filed.

All grants are needs-based and can be used at any Catholic elementary school within the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Typically, awards have ranged from \$250 to \$1,200 per qualified student. Do not miss out on the wonderful opportunity to apply for tuition assistance through the Catholic Education Foundation (CEF).

If you were awarded last year, you will need to re-apply. The assistance is only good for one year.

If you would also like to be considered for the **Cardinal Pacelli's Education Fund**, you must first apply for this tuition grant from Catholic Education Foundation. This is all done through **FACTS Grant and Aid Management**.

Applications will be accepted through February 3, 2024.

We are excited to again be offering **Welcome Scholarships** to first in the family incoming preschool or kindergarten students! We are also happy to be able to continue the lottery for students of elementary school employees. Both programs will kick off in January and more details will be sent to you soon.

Mental Health Resources for Parents Post Pandemic Parenting. This 3-hour, 3-module video masterclass is a critical watch for parents and teachers. Divided into nine easy-to-watch 20-minute lessons, the program is produced by nationally recognized psychologist and parenting expert, Dr. Robin Arthur, former Chief of Psychology at the Lindner Center of HOPE. Parents are taught how to deal with the post-covid impacts of stress, anxiety, and depression affecting so many of their children's mental health.


