What is the meaning of the 2nd Advent candle?

The second advent candle ("The Bethlehem Candle") is also purple and represents peace. Peace is a central theme of the advent season but it is the main focus of the second week of Advent.

Power of the Pen

This year the Power of the Pen District Tournament will be held at Cardinal Pacelli School on **January 28, 2023**. Power of the Pen is an organization that encourages middle school students to engage in creative writing. Our 7th and 8th graders have been successful in Power of the Pen writing competitions against other middle schools across the state for the past several years. Last

year's competition team qualified four writers for the state tournament and two of those writers finished in the top 50 in the state!

With us holding the district tournament here at our school, we need a tournament sponsor. Mental Health Resources for Parents

Post Pandemic Parenting. This 3-hour, 3-module video masterclass is a critical watch for parents and teachers. Divided into nine easy-to-watch 20-minute lessons, the program is produced by nationally recognized psychologist and parenting expert, Dr. Robin Arthur, former Chief of Psychology at the Lindner Center of HOPE. Parents are taught how to deal with the post-covid impacts of stress, anxiety, and depression affecting so many of their children's mental health.

From the School Clinic

We received a Health Alert regarding an outbreak of measles in central Ohio.

"Columbus Public Health, Ohio Department of Health (ODH), Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and other local public health jurisdictions are working closely with clinical and community partners to respond to an ongoing outbreak of measles in central Ohio."

Measles is a viral infection that spreads through coughing and sneezing. It is very contagious, but most school-aged children who are fully vaccinated with two doses of measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) vaccine are protected from measles.

"Measles is a vaccine preventable disease. The measles vaccine is highly protective; one dose of measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine provides 93% protection against measles and two doses provide 97% protection."

However, 3 in 100 people who have received two doses of MMR vaccine will still get measles if exposed to the virus. Therefore, we want you to provide you with information about measles, and the signs and symptoms to look for in your child.

Usually about 8-12 days (but up to 21 days) after exposure, measles begins with a mild to moderate fever accompanied by cough, runny nose, and red eyes. Two or three days later, the fever spikes, often as high as 104-105°F. At the same time, a red blotchy rash appears, usually first on the face, along the hairline and behind the ears. The rash rapidly spreads downward to the chest and back and, finally, to the thighs and feet.

Emergency Closing of School

In inclement weather, the students will never be marked tardy. Please drive carefully and with caution. Use your discretion as to safety.

We will **EITHER CANCEL SCHOOL OR HAVE A TWO-HOUR DELAY** which is a **9:50 AM START TIME**.

If we have a two-hour delay, it is at the parent's discretion whether to send their ½ day Kindergarten, Pre-K, or Pre-School students. Classes will be in session.

If Forest Hills is on a delay and our school is on a regular schedule, parents whose children use these bus services can provide their own transportation to school or wait for the delayed buses to pick their children up. Our students **WILL NOT** be marked tardy.

If Cincinnati Public or Forest Hills cancels school, and our school is still in session, parents whose children use these bus services need to provide their own transportation. **If** Cincinnati Public Schools close, Forest Hills will **NOT** transport our students.

IF school is in session and we need to close school early, the One Call Now automated phone system and email messages using RenWeb will be used. In addition, the information will be posted on our website.

Catholic Education Foundation Tuition Aid Grants

The application window for Catholic Education Foundation (CEF) 2023-2024 Elementary School Tuition Assistance Scholarships is open between now and February 3, 2023. The process will work, as it has in the past with families applying through **FACTS Grant and Aid Management**. Families should upload their 2021 tax return when applying, this eliminates the need to wait for 2022 to be filed.

All grants are needs-based and can be used at any Catholic elementary school within the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Typically, awards have ranged from \$250 to \$1,200 per qualified student.



Do not miss out on the wonderful opportunity to apply for tuition assistance through the Catholic Education Foundation (CEF).

If you were awarded last year, you will need to re-apply. The assistance is only good for one year. If you would also like to be considered for the Cardinal Pacelli's Education Fund, you must first apply for this tuition grant from Catholic Education Foundation. This is all done through FACTS Grant and Aid Management.

Applications will be accepted through February 3, 2024.

We are excited to again be offering **Welcome Scholarships** to first in the family incoming preschool or kindergarten students! We are also happy to be able to continue the lottery for students of elementary school employees. Both programs will kick off in January and more details will be sent to you soon.


