Mrs. Cento's Message

Dear Pacelli Families and Friends.

Wednesday, January 25, 2023 was to be a "real" snow day. I foolishly followed the Forest Hills School District and Cincinnati

Public Schools and closed as they did. My main reason for going along with their recommendation was primarily about bus transportation and safety for all our students and staff. They have a greater number of resources in deciding to delay or close their schools than Cardinal Pacelli. About 50% of our students rely on bus transportation and our staff come from many areas of the city. I try to look at all sides including the inconvenience of the working parents who need supervision for their children who would be home and those who would be inconvenienced with private transportation to and from school. I guess we were all caught up in the hype by the media and meteorologists about this imminent winter storm that never happened as predicted. Even highway signs all over the city were sharing this information as early as Tuesday morning.

Several of you may have noticed that this was a different procedure as in past years. I would agree with you as it has always been in the morning when schools would decide the risk for school attendance on bad weather days. I can assure you, in the future, school will only be closed or delayed for weather if I see a blizzard raging before my eyes in the evening or in the morning. I should have listened to what my gut was telling me and remained open. However, I believe we would have been the only school around who were in attendance.

Thank you for your patience. Delays and closings are never easy on anyone!

weeklong celebration is sponsored by the National Catholic Educational Association (NCEA).

Catholic Education Foundation Tuition Aid Grants

The Catholic Education Foundation for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati (CEF) was established through the generosity of many to the One Love Capital Campaign. The

foundation manages a permanent endowment in order to offer yearly scholarship opportunities to students in grades K-12. <u>Click here</u> to learn more about the application process and deadlines.

The application window for Catholic Education Foundation (CEF) 2023-2024 Elementary School Tuition Assistance Scholarships is open between now and February 3, 2023. The process will work, as it has in the past with families applying through **FACTS Grant and Aid Management**. Families should upload their 2021 tax return when applying, this eliminates the need to wait for 2022 to be filed.

All grants are needs-based and can be used at any Catholic elementary school within the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Typically, awards have ranged from \$250 to \$1,200 per qualified student. Do not miss out on the wonderful opportunity to apply for tuition assistance through the Catholic Education Foundation (CEF).

If you were awarded last year, you will need to re-apply. The assistance is only good for one year.

If you would also like to be considered for the **Cardinal Pacelli's Education Fund,** you must first apply for this tuition grant from Catholic Education Foundation. This is all done through **FACTS Grant and Aid Management**.

For the second year, the CEF is happy to offer **Welcome Tuition Scholarships** for the 2023-2024 school year! There will be 250, \$1000 tuition scholarships available to **incoming preschool and kindergarten students**. To be eligible, the student(s) must be the first child in their immediate family to attend a Catholic school. Each family must complete an application at https://catholicbestchoice.org/affordability/. These scholarships will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis.

Please do not delay! Applications for all Catholic Education Foundation Tuition Grants will be accepted through February 3, 2023.

Just Try It Lunch


