Dear Pacelli Families and Friends,

Enrollment & Registration

Enrollment Deadlines: Late fees have now been assessed for those who have not registered for the upcoming school year. As of March 11th, a \$25 late fee was added for each child whose enrollment has not been completed and submitted. This late fee will increase \$25 per child each month (for example, the late fee after April 10th is \$50; May is \$75; June is \$100, July is \$125, and August is \$150). PLEASE NOTE: Late fees are NOT applied towards tuition.


