Dear Pacelli Families and Friends,

<u>Cardinal Pacelli School Website</u> We are very happy to announce that Cardinal Pacelli has a new <u>School Website</u>! The new site is a great representation of our school and makes it easier for us to share news and events! The design has been months in the

In the transition to our new school website along with putting more security on our servers, there were a couple of glitches regarding emails from RenWeb last week. Some problems still have not been resolved and we continue to troubleshoot. You can always check into your Family Portal for Report Cards, Attendance, Classes, Schedules, Grades, and Behavior Notifications. You may want to check you SPAM for emails that were sent via Renweb late last week.

<u>School Calendar</u> I am currently finalizing the school calendar for next school year. It should be available by the end of March. For those who are planning summer vacations, Welcome Back Sunday will be on August 13, 2023 and the first day of school will either be Tuesday, August 15th or Wednesday, August 16th. I hope this helps with your planning.

<u>School of Faith</u> Beginning the 2023-24 school year our teachers will participate in monthly workshops on Personal Faith Development. An important prong of the School of Faith mission is to minister in schools. John Leyendecker and Dave Staples, School of Faith instructors, partner with grade schools and high schools in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati to form administrators, faculty and staff more deeply in the faith so they can radiate Christ to their students.

We look forward to this time with each other exploring a deeper faith experience and be witnesses of faith to our students by sharing our personal commitment.

News from the School Nurse We are seeing some conjunctivitis (pink eye) which can be very contagious, yet it is not always required to exclude these students from school. We are asking parents to contact their pediatrician for treatment/directions.

Personal hygiene is very important to protect oneself. Please spend some time at home revisiting the importance of hand washing/sanitizer use throughout the day, along with reminders to keep hands off of faces/eyes.

Information from the CDC:

Bacterial Conjunctivitis - Mild bacterial conjunctivitis may get better without antibiotic treatment and without causing any complications. It often improves in 2 to 5 days without treatment but can take 2 weeks to go away completely.



Your doctor may prescribe an antibiotic, usually given topically as eye drops or ointment, for bacterial conjunctivitis. Antibiotics may help shorten the length of infection, reduce complications, and reduce the spread to others. Antibiotics may be necessary in the following cases:

- · With discharge (pus)
- · When conjunctivitis occurs in people whose immune system is compromised
- · When certain bacteria are suspected
- · Talk with your doctor about the best treatment options for your infection.

<u>IOWA & CogAT Testing</u> Standardized testing for students in Grades 2-8 begin on Tuesday, March 14th through April 6th. Our schedule will test students in the mornings only from 8:00 – 9:30 AM and will complete a couple of tests each day. Please do your best to help by getting your children to bed at a good hour and up early enough for a healthy breakfast. This will greatly improve their ability to focus better on the test. Also, please refrain from being absent or tardy from school on these testing days unless your child is ill. It is difficult for us to make up tests that are missed within the testing window

Enrollment Deadlines: To avoid late fees, please complete enrollment by March 10th, 2023. Please note that beginning March 11th, a \$25 late fee will be added for each child whose enrollment has not been completed and submitted. This late fee will increase \$25 per child each month (for example, the late fee after April 10th is \$50; May is \$75; June is \$100, July is \$125, and August is \$150). PLEASE NOTE: Late fees are NOT applied towards tuition.

To complete our online enrollment process, you will access our ParentsWeb through your existing login.

The online process should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back later.

A Beacons of Light Update from Fr. Adam

We are beginning the process of yearly goals to grow together as a Family of Churches. <u>Needed Items</u>: Body wash, toothpaste, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, canned proteins, and ready to eat meals.


Capstone Project - Help Fill Backpacks for Foster Kids
