**Leadership** Over the next couple of weeks I will be visiting homerooms in grades 5 – 8 to discuss the importance of student leadership. Ed Choice Expansion Currently we have about 150 students in the application phase of the Ed Choice Expansion Scholarship. I know there are still several families out there who have not applied and could potentially receive the full scholarship amount for school tuition based on the change in the poverty rate from 250% to 450%. This scholarship is NOT based on the location where you reside but on income only. That means all families who reside in Cincinnati, Anderson, Mariemont, Indian Hills, etc. will qualify for some amount toward your school tuition. I STRONGLY encourage you to complete the application, create an OH|ID Parent Portal Account with the Ohio Department of Education, and upload your financial information to that account. 
