Although October 31st is about 6 weeks away, you might want to think about purchasing the uniform pants for your child. On November 1st, this becomes part of the uniform until April 1st. Navy Blue uniform pants can be worn for both boys and girls. A reminder for girls who have skirts more than 3 inches above the knee must either wear uniform pants, tights or leggings or purchase a new uniform skirt. Tights and leggings for all girls can either be white, black or navy blue. Socks for all students can only be white, black, or navy blue. A uniform pullover or sweatshirt cannot have a hood. <u>Free & Reduced Lunch Count</u> All of our school families are asked to review and complete an Income Eligibility Guidelines Form for Title I funding. This information is very important to ensure

our continued participation in Federal and State Programs. If you do not meet the eligibility, please just sign the document and return it so that we know you have reviewed the information. For those who do meet the eligibility for Free/Reduced Lunch, all your responses are kept confidential and are only used to see how many of our families would qualify based on income and number of dependents.

These programs provide a variety of materials and services for the children, teachers, and our school. Programs affected include Title I, Free and Reduced lunch, and E-Rate. *Although Cardinal Pacelli does NOT participate in the Free/Reduced Lunch Program, the data collected will help to fund other areas including Title I and E-Rate.* It is one of the few benefits our children receive from your tax dollars and we do not want to lose it. <a href="CLICK HERE">CLICK HERE</a> to obtain a copy of the document.

Some are late on the video bulletins. We are mandated by the Archdiocese to have all our volunteers compliant in SafeParish. This also includes those involved with athletics. Please take a few minutes to review your account and make it current if needed. Weekly emails go out to all those who are not approved for various reasons. If you are an Approved volunteer according to SafeParish, you will have a name badge in the blue index box at the front desk of the school office. If you have just registered, it may take a couple of days for your electronic background check to come through. I recommend getting registered now and not waiting if you plan on being a volunteer for any event at school. If you wait until the night before you plan on volunteering here, you may not be approved in that short amount of time, especially if you are a new registrant.

<u>Ed Choice Expansion Update</u> By my latest calculation, there are approximately 75 students/30 families who have not applied for the Ed Choice Scholarship.




