



Financial Assistance for Cardinal Pacelli Families

Tuition Assistance from Our Lord Christ the King Parish/Cardinal Pacelli School

Apply through FACTS.

SCHOOL REGISTRATION: Families must have completed the on-line registration and paid the registration fees. School and technology fees for the next school year will be assessed with the first tuition payment of the year in July.

AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE: depends on the availability of funds.

DEMONSTRATED FINANCIAL NEED: Families must apply with FACTS. Your child will need to be registered before applying for aid. Just log into your existing account and choose financial aid.

EdChoice Scholarship & Expansion Programs

Cardinal Pacelli School accepts scholarships provided through the EdChoice Traditional Scholarship Program and the EdChoice Expansion Program.

The [EdChoice Traditional Scholarship Program](#) provides state-funded scholarships to students who attend or are assigned to an EdChoice designated public school building. Families who live in neighborhoods covered by these individual schools can apply for a scholarship to use towards tuition at Cardinal Pacelli School. It is important to note that this scholarship is only for incoming students who do not currently attend a private school. However, incoming kindergarten students of current Cardinal Pacelli School families and siblings of high school students currently receiving the scholarship can apply. The complete list of designated public schools can be found on the Department of Education website and is also located in the school office.

The [Edchoice Expansion Scholarship](#) is an income-based program for students in grades Kindergarten – 8 based on family income level. Scholarships for EdChoice Expansion are awarded based on the Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of a family's household. If a family's household income is at or below 450 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, they will be awarded the maximum scholarship amount. If a family's household income is at or above 451 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, the student's scholarship award will be prorated based on the chart below.

Federal Poverty Level	Award Amount for Grades K-8
0-450%	\$6,165
451-500%	\$5,200
501-550%	\$3,650
551-600%	\$2,600
601-650%	\$1,850
651-700%	\$1,300
701-750%	\$900
751% or higher	\$650

*Families of students currently enrolled at Cardinal Pacelli School can apply for this scholarship, unlike the traditional scholarship described above.
