

7th & 8th Grade - Snow & Remote Day Expectations

Snow days are great, but summer break starting on time is even better. If that means doing a *little bit* of schoolwork while stuck in the house, it's better than having to be at school in June when you could be at the pool.

This is NOT meant to be a full day of academic drudgery - rather, some light schoolwork to keep our curriculum on track and hold students accountable.

Required Materials

Students will need a reliable device to access Google Classroom and other online resources.

Snow & Remote Day Schedule

In the event of a day off school, the 7th and 8th grade teachers will be posting material and following this schedule:

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| 7:00 AM | "Attendance" question posted to Google Classroom. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- due by 10:00 AM to be marked "Present" Daily assignment posted for each subject. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Assignments might be specific to what was completed in class the day before, or work that will prepare students for class on the day of their return.- Assignments within a subject should not take students more than 20 minutes in total. |
| 10:00 AM | "Attendance" question due. |
| 1:00 PM | Cut-off on emails to teachers about assignments. |
| 7:00 PM | Daily assignments due. |

This schedule gives a window of three (3) hours to "take attendance" and twelve (12) hours for students to complete their required assignments for the day, allowing students to choose when they would like to do their work, and enabling them to have the support of family in the evenings if necessary.
