

BLIZZARD BAGS - ENGLISH

Day 1 - Writing Prompt:

Today you are going to complete the writing prompt in your writing journal (if you have it at home) or on a separate piece of paper. The writing prompt is: Write a story about what it would be like to climb to the very top of the highest mountain in the world. Explain your journey. What challenges did you face? Who was with you? What items did you bring? How did you feel when you made it to the top? What was the name of the mountain that you climbed? Choose five spelling words from our list to include in your story and make sure they are circled. Write at least half a page.

Day 2 - Create Haiku Poem:

Today you are going to write a haiku poem. A haiku is a short, unrhymed poem that is made up of three lines. There must be 5 syllables in the first line, 7 syllables in the second line, and 5 syllables in the third line. You are going to create a haiku about winter, the beauty of snow, footprints in the snow, the silence of winter, an animal that is in hibernation, etc. Write it nice and neat on a white piece of computer paper. Check your spelling, capitalization, and punctuation.

An example:

Falling from the sky.

Silent, soft, still, snow settles.

One blink later – gone.

Day 3 - Decorate Haiku Poem:

Today you are going to decorate your haiku poem that you wrote with images and make it look like the scene you described in your poem. Make it colorful, be creative, and have fun!
