

Financial Assistance for Cardinal Pacelli Families

Tuition Assistance from Our Lord Christ the King Parish/Cardinal Pacelli School

- Apply through <u>FACTS</u> Family Portal Login
- SCHOOL REGISTRATION: Families must have completed the online enrollment registration and paid the registration fees. School and technology fees for the next school year will be assessed with the first tuition payment of the year in July, 2025.
 - Only active parishioners are eligible for the Cardinal Pacelli education fund assistance
 - Enrollment will begin in February, 2025

AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE: depends on the availability of funds

DEMONSTRATED FINANCIAL NEED: Families must apply with FACTS. Your child will need to be registered before applying for aid. Just log into your existing account and choose financial aid.

> <u>Tuition Assistance Grants through the Archdiocese of Cincinnati</u>

The Catholic Education Fund (CEF) for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati is currently accepting applications for elementary school students (K-8) tuition assistance grants. The Catholic Education Foundation tuition aid program became a reality through the *One Faith, One Hope, One Love Campaign*. Due to the generosity of local parishes, including ours, the Catholic Education Foundation will again be able to offer financial assistance! <u>All families who plan to apply for financial assistance from Cardinal Pacelli School must first apply for assistance from this source.</u>

EdChoice Scholarship & Expansion Programs

Cardinal Pacelli School accepts scholarships provided through the EdChoice Traditional Scholarship Program and the EdChoice Expansion Program

The EdChoice Traditional Scholarship Program

- Provides state-funded scholarships to students who attend or are assigned to an EdChoice designated public school building.
- Families who live in neighborhoods covered by these individual schools can apply for a scholarship to use towards tuition at Cardinal Pacelli School. It is important to note that this scholarship is only for incoming students who do not currently attend a private school. However, incoming kindergarten students of current Cardinal Pacelli School families and siblings of high school students currently receiving the scholarship can apply.

The Edchoice Expansion Scholarship

- An income-based program for students in grades Kindergarten 8 based on family income level.
- Scholarships for EdChoice Expansion are awarded based on the Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of a family's household. If a family's household income is at or below 450 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, they will be awarded the maximum scholarship amount. If a family's household income is at or above 451 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, the student's scholarship award will be prorated.
